DECLARING LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE SUPPLY OF SECURITY SERVICES

WHEREAS the University of the Philippines Mindanao through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) posted the Invitation to Bid for the bidding of the Supply of Security Services FY 2020 with an approved budget amounting to P6,876,697.32 in the PhilGEPS website, UP Mindanao website, and in a conspicuous place within the campus for at least seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, as a result of such postings three (3) bidders purchased bid documents and submitted their bids upon the deadline for submission on November 27, 2019;

WHEREAS, upon preliminary evaluation of the documentary requirements submitted by the three bidders, all of them were declared eligible for bidding;

WHEREAS, upon opening of the financial envelope submitted the following were the financial bids as read:
